



Academic Select Program

Hershey Christian School desires to partner with parents in our local communities as we provide a program that helps to complete a student's portfolio in grades 7-12. Many families are searching for specific courses to meet the individual needs of their children. We offer a variety of biblically integrated courses that will benefit families that participate in this program.

Please complete the following steps for admission to the HCS Academic Select Program:

1. Parents need to complete the ASP registration form.
2. Students need to complete the student application form.
3. Students need to provide a signature indicating that they will abide by the HCS Student Code of Conduct.
4. Parents and students will select courses for the registration form.
5. Parents must submit authorization from the superintendent of their local school district granting approval to home school.
6. Registration fee is submitted with the registration materials.
7. An interview will be scheduled with the secondary principal.
8. Notification of admission into the program will follow.

Academic Select Program Guidelines:

- Students will be officially enrolled into courses after the tuition fee has been paid.
- The school reserves the right to deny enrollment into specific courses if class sizes are too large or for reasons that would affect the quality of education in the classroom.
- Registration is closed for part-time students on August 10 for first semester or full-year courses and January 10 for second semester courses.
- Part-time students may enroll in a maximum of 3.0 credits per school year.
- Course descriptions and prerequisites can be found in the HCS Educational Planning Guide and Secondary School Handbook.
- Immunization records indicating compliance with state regulations must be received before students attend classes.
- Emergency forms must be completed for each school year before classes begin.
- Students will be subject to all rules and regulations applicable to HCS students and must become familiar with the student handbook.
- All policies regarding class attendance are applicable to students enrolled as part-time students.
- Students will be required to follow the dress code as described in our student handbook.
- Part-time Jr. High students are eligible to participate in extracurricular activities, including athletics, if they are actively enrolled in a minimum of 1.0 credit per semester.
- Part-time Sr. High students are eligible to attend extracurricular clubs and programs (except for PIAA athletics), if they are enrolled in a minimum of 1.0 credit per semester.



Academic Select Program Fee Schedule

Registration Fees:

Activity Fees:

- \$100 activity fee for each extracurricular activity
- Students enrolled in the Academic Select Program are eligible to participate in Middle School Athletics, Drama, Photography Club, and other extracurricular activities

Tuition Fees:

- Payment for enrollment into designated classes must be paid in full prior to the student attending class.
- Financial aid and tuition discounts are not available for part-time students
- If a student withdraws from a course prior to the completion of the course, there will be a \$50 withdrawal fee assessed.
- Charges for the days of instruction will be determined on a per diem basis. Under no circumstances will the family be assessed more than the total fee for the course.

Textbook Information:

- Parents are responsible to purchase textbooks for courses that require textbooks
- A list of required books will be provided for selected courses after student admission to the program
- New textbooks or used textbooks can be ordered online at discount rates
